

North Pocono Band Parents Meeting Minutes, September 3, 2009

The NPBP held their monthly meeting on September 3, 2009. Michelle Silvia called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. There was an amendment to the August 6, 2009 minutes. A \$100 non-refundable deposit is due in October (not November) for Disney. The minutes from August 6, 2009 were then accepted by Pati Pawlick and seconded by Donna Mela.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Brenda Antosh reported the current starting balance for the students and the band parents is \$20,274.84. Student accounts are approximately \$11,308.77. Available to the band parents is \$2,265.46. The Disney CD balance is \$10,000. The treasurer's report was accepted by Chris Silvia and seconded by Diane Lewis.

FUNDRAISING: Fundraisers for October will be Krispy Kreme donuts and candles. Students should look for information in the band room. August's fundraiser at Tasty Swirl was successful. Our profit was \$236.00. An additional \$14.00 was donated by Tasty Swirl, bringing our total profit for the night to \$250.00.

DISNEY TRIP: Trip folders will be handed out to students soon. Only 32 students currently have the required deposits in their accounts. A final count will be required soon. If you are planning to go to Disney, please get your deposits sent in!! Chaperones can begin paying their money now. Not everyone who signed the chaperone sheet will be selected. It depends on how many students are attending and how many seats are available. If you are not chosen, your payments will be refunded. Parents not chosen as chaperones can contact John Maddon to book the trip on their own.

MR. T: After the football games, if a student isn't going back to school on the bus, Mr. T. must see the parent with the student before they can leave. Students are responsible for getting their uniform and instrument back to the school.

MEMBERSHIP: Please fill out and return your band parent membership forms. Membership entitles the student to be considered for the senior scholarships given by the band parents. Students must be members for all four years.

NEW BUSINESS: Joe Antosh informed us that Kim and Peggy Kramer were involved in a car accident. He asked for suggestions as to how the band could help. A \$100 gas card was agreed on. The motion was made by Tracy Rosencranz and seconded by Judy Beers.

Drum major, Stephanie Aten, asked for permission to hold a bake sale at one of the basketball games for her senior project. She will donate the profits to the band towards the Disney trip. A motion was made by Donna Toth and seconded by Pati Pawlick.
